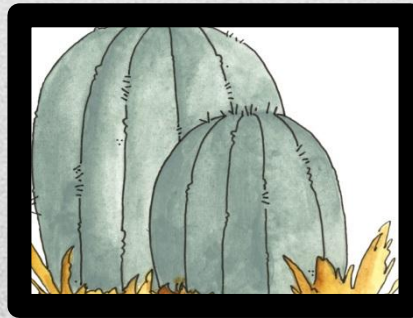
ABOUT ME

SCHOOL HOURS

- Demonstrate grade-level proficiency in math, language arts and reading.
- Read and comprehend previously unseen text at the end-of-year level.
- Achieve an overall average of 70% in reading, language arts, math, science and social studies.
- Demonstrate proficiency on specified standards in writing.
- Demonstrate proficiency on most of the grade level/TEKS or be expected to do so early in the next year.



4TH GRADE PROMOTION STANDARDS

- The state allows us to have 3 parties per year: Winter, Fiesta and End of The Year.
- Only store bought individual treats may be brought to school to celebrate a child's birthday. They will be served the last 5 minutes of school.
- Cakes, party bags, drinks, balloons, etc. are not permitted and will be sent back home.
- Teachers or students may not pass out invitations to select children. Either the entire class must receive one or all boys or all girls must receive one in order for the teacher or student to pass out invitations.
- Snacks for students may only be provided by the parent.

COMMUNICATION

VISITORS



- Toys may not be brought to school unless the teacher sends a note home.

TOYS/CELL PHONES
